





THE RESORT










This is Four Corners Country. Here in the San Juan Mountains that form Tamarron's setting, there are more soaring 14,000ft. peaks than in any other part of Colorado. This is definitely territory you'll want to explore. 

Drive out from Tamarron, and one awesome vista literally follows another. The famous San Juan Skyway loops through some of the most dramatic high country in the world. It climbs through Red Mountain Pass, at 11,075 feet. And it passes through towns whose very names are



legend. Gorgeous, alpine Ouray, where Box Canvon Falls cascades into its plunging canyon. Silverton, the former notoriously rough-and-ready silver mining center, now a National Historic Landmark. Near Mancos, the Skyway also skirts the ancient and mysterious Anasazi cliff dwellings in Mesa Verde National Park—which you simply have to see. Another way, and a great one, to take in Tamarron's glorious mountain scenery is via the old-time, cliff-hanging Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad, which was used to bring the ore down from Silverton. ☐ Durango itself offers a special fascination. It's replete with historic 18th- and 19th-century houses. Its restaurants are as richly varied and interesting as the town itself. And you can stroll and shop through authentic and surprisingly urbane art and sculpture galleries, featuring work by famed Native American artists. 

Travel to Durango is certainly easier than in days gone by. Tamarron is located 18 miles north of Durango. Fly direct to the new Durango air terminal from Denver, Phoenix and Albuquerque. Or drive via Route 550 and the Navajo Trail, Highway 160. No matter which you choose, Tamarron is easy to reach. And when you leave, it will be with memories that will make you want to return time and again.
