

Fire Update

Members,

For those returning to Glacier, U.S. Highway 550 is now completely open with unrestricted access. Evacuated residents from Glacier Club to Needles can return to their homes and businesses.

Scattered showers are expected to continue through this afternoon. In some areas, the fire received more than a quarter-inch of rain within an hour this morning. Fire behavior will still be limited today, and there should be little to no growth. The chance of ignition is minimal.

The 416 Fire is at 34,161 acres and is currently at 25 percent containment.

Glacier is planning to be fully open Saturday, June 23, subject to conditions from the fire. Upon re-opening, tee-times for both courses will begin at 8 a.m. By the week of June 25, all member and outside events will resume as planned, including the Men's and Ladies days.
